We have recognised this has to change and transformed ourselves within just a few years into an organisation fully embracing digitalisation in the delivery of our services. RLB Hong Kong was certified in June 2021 as the first Quantity Surveying/Cost Consultant firm in Hong Kong to achieve ISO 19650 certification. This demonstrates our commitment to leading the implementation of BIM and emerging technologies that support cost planning, procurement and cost management throughout the whole project cycle.

With vast experience in working with different stakeholders across a variety of platforms using BIM and information technologies, RLB published "RLB 5D BIM Standards for Use in Hong Kong" in November 2020 for all stakeholders, up and down the supply chain. This is a set of standard document which serves as a communication bridge between the quantity surveyor's measurement rules and the BIM naming convention. The publication demonstrates our willingness to share our knowledge with the industry as part of our mission to create an open and collaborative working environment.

We launched our own RLB e-Tendering System in 2021 which provides a user-friendly, Internet-based means for suppliers or contractors to receive tender invitations and to submit tenders in response of these invitations including BIM delivery. Together with other previously already deployed E-Tendering modules, our e-Tendering solution integrates all parts of the tendering process in a digital and green environment. This demonstrates our investment in innovative research and development to streamline our business processes and enhance them with digital assets.
